

Frequently Asked Questions:

1. Will the participants of the Boot Camp actually be performing the nerve blocks?

The participants will actually be performing nerve blocks under supervision of the course directors.

2. How many nerve blocks do you expect each participant to perform over the two-day camp?

Each participant can expect to perform between 5 and 10 peripheral nerve blocks during the two-day program.

3. What language will be used during the Boot Camp?

The official language during the course is English. Our staff however is multilingual (Dutch, English, French, German).

4. Are there any legal issues in terms of licensing, state rules, liability etc? If so how will they be taken care of?

Participants must be medical doctors, anesthesiologists, and hold an active license to practice medicine. The course participants will be covered by liability insurance.

5. Would it be possible to get a copy of written schedule or plan of the activities for the two days? A roadmap for the two days, so to speak?
